## LIST OF MOTIONS PASSED AT MEETINGS

### 2004

- 5/1/04 \* SSF to forward cheque for \$2000- for share of first 150m of fence for CFW oval as agreed provided Cricket & SSC contribute the same. SSF to reapply for a grant to construct a Safety Barrier/Screen at southern end. SSF to construct 150m of fence on the northern side of CFW and seek donation of materials and labour.
- 3/5/04 \* Dual registration be permitted between Stanthorpe Junior Soccer Assn and Stanthorpe Soccer Fed for players of the appropriate age.  
\* Linda Martin appointed Referees Sub Committee Rep, Lyn Gilmour appointed Referees Appointments officer, Allan Taylor appointed coach of Referees Sub committee, Martin Hodgson appointed Junior Soccer rep.
- 17/5/04 \* For the 2005 season, ladies players must turn fourteen (14) in that calendar year to be eligible to play open ladies soccer in the Stanthorpe Soccer Fed comp.  
\* Subject to provision and clarification of the official team sheet, Tenterfield ladies soccer team shall lose points and goals associated with the match in question as a result of fielding one (1) more player than outlined in the SSF By laws.
- 21/6/04 \* Referees budget adopted with referee membership fees set at \$160- for the 2004 season.  
\* Frank Arcidiacono to be Stanthorpe Soccer Federation director of Coaching.
- 5/7/04 \* Frank Arcidiacono to conduct player assessments with the full support of the SSF board. Frank accepted position on the basis that once a final decision had been made on a player's suitability there would be no further discussion on the matter.
- 2/8/04 \* For 2004, clubs will have the administration fee refunded for players having played 2 games or less. However, insurance fee will be charged for all players regardless of number of games played.  
\* The Federation meet cost of providing anchors to all goal posts at all venues in our competition.
- 8/11/04 \* The \$500- appeal fee for Brendan Perkins has not been lodged in time and an appeal will not be heard.
